You can start the program any time you want during the year. The program will be a great experience and opportunity to further your career. You will get to know American work environment and their work methods.

ICCE, authorized by the Department of State is a sponsor organization and gives opportunity to start the program for thousands of students each year.

REQUIREMENTS

INTERNSHIP

- length of the program 12 months
- age 20-33
- readiness to explore the USA culture through participation in the program
- students
- person who completed studies within last 12 months have to start the program not later than 1 year of the completion of studies
- fluent English

TRAINING PROGRAM

- length of the program 12 or 18 months
- age 20-33
- readiness to explore the USA culture through participation in the program
- person with completed secondary school and 5 years of experience in the training field
- person that completed studies more than 12 months ago and has at least 1 year experience
- fluent English

WHAT INTERSHIP AND TRAINING PROGRAM REALLY IS?

The Internship program allows university and college students from around the world an opportunity to develop practical skills and reinforce their academic studies by interning with businesses and organizations in the U.S. for up to 12 months. These entry-level participants are between the ages of 18-28 and include university students and recent graduates with an education in their field of interest.

The Training Program offers young professionals from around the world the opportunity to enhance their education and experience through professional training with companies in the United States. All trainees have a university degree or certificate and one year of professional experience in their career field or a minimum of 5 years of professional experience in their career field.

THE PROGRAM FEE INCLUDES

- job offer
- DS-2019 – document issued by the Department of State that allows you to get J-1 visa and start legal work in the USA
- medical insurance for the whole duration of the program

- orientation before or after arriving in the USA
- help in booking return plane ticket from Poland to the United States.
- Information materials
- help in receiving J-1 visa, particularly setting an interview, delivering all necessary documents to the proper consulate and collecting participants' passports.

HOUSING

Most of the US companies will not offer you housing. There will be few companies like hotels and resorts that will offer housing for their trainees. Some companies offer help with finding housing by advising where you can search. You can look for housing opportunities on this website: www.craigslist.org

PROCEDURE

- candidate is required to send detailed CV (resume) in English with photo, based on the information in CV the candidate will be offered a job
- interview with the employer after the acceptance the job offer is ready to be signed
- program fee is transferred to the sponsor organization ICCE
- candidate is required to submit all necessary documents such as: transcripts, student status confirmation, reference letters
- after submitting all documents sponsor organization ICCE issues DS-2019 and sends it within 8 weeks.

- flight to the USA
